Privacy Policy



We at Cryptofaces.com (“we”, “us”, “Website” or “Cryptofaces”) respect your privacy. This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) applies to personal and non-personal customer information obtained by Cryptofaces through our Website, as well as our web browser extension Cryptofaces or any other source to which this Policy is linked or referenced.


The Policy describes the types of information we obtain about visitors of our Website (“You”, “Your”) and how we use said information. We also describe the measures we take to protect the security of the information and how you can contact us about our privacy practices.


1. Types of information we obtain

1.1. Non-personal Information:

1.1 (a) When you visit Cryptofaces.com our system obtains information regarding your use of our Website through automated means, including, but not limited to, cookies, web server logs, JavaScript and similar technologies.

1.1 (b) The information we obtain in this manner or which may be provided by the mobile devices you use with the Website may include the time of visit, pages visited, and time spent on each page of the webpages; referring site details (such as the name of the website, the name of the searching system, the name of the social network etc.); the type of web browser; browser language; type of operating system; flash version, JavaScript support, screen resolution, and screen color processing ability; network location and IP address; downloading files; clicks on external links as well as video on the Website; form submission errors; scroll depth; interactions with Website widgets; geolocation information.





1.2. Personal Information:

1.2 (a) In a limited number of cases, we may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us, such as your name and email. We do not collect and process your personal information without your consent.


1.2 (b) By voluntarily providing us with personal information, including, without limitation, by using the Website, you expressly and irrevocably agree to our use of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you provide personal information to us, you acknowledge and agree that such personal information may be transferred from your current location to the servers of the Website and to the servers of authorized third parties.

1.3. Additional Information:

1.3 (a) From time to time we reserve the right to obtain information about legal entities that visit our Website, through their representatives.

1.3 (b) We may obtain information about the website of a legal entity, the name of the legal entity, the contact information of the legal entity, the country of incorporation, and the link to the ICO of the legal entity (if applicable).

1.4. We may use our web browser extension to obtain information described in this Policy. Our web browser extension can only access specific information that you have explicitly granted permission to access. We cannot and do not track your browsing history.





2. How we collect information?

2.1. We may collect personal identification information such as your email and name from you only if you voluntarily submit such information to us. You can always refuse to supply personal identification information. We may collect non-personal identification information about you whenever you interact with our Website.

3. How we use the information we obtain?


3.1. We use non-personal information for the following purposes:

3.1 (a) to prevent you from seeing unnecessary advertisements or requiring you to re-enter the Website more than is necessary;

3.1 (b) to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our Website and which parts of the Website are most popular;

3.1 (c) to improve the content of our web pages and to customize the content and layout of our pages;

3.1 (d) to deliver the information you request from the Website, such as an article, news, review, analysis etc;






3.2. If at any time you provide us with your personal information, we collect that information. Areas in which we may use your personal information include, but are not limited to, providing you with email newsletters, feedback and especially the ability to comment on articles, interactive forms. If you provide us with your email address, you may receive periodic promotional emails from us and carefully selected partners with information regarding special offers or services. You may also receive informational emails from us related to administrative notices regarding the operation of the Website. You may at any time withdraw your consent to receive electronic emails by sending a withdrawal notice to Cryptofaces or by pressing the dedicated button ("an unsubscribe button") in any email from Cryptofaces.

3.3. We also have the right to disclose your identity to any third party who is claiming that any content posted by you constitutes a violation of their intellectual property rights, or of their right to privacy.

3.4. You agree that we may share with and transfer your information that no longer identifies you to a third party who is a contracting party with us, usually our outsourced services' providers or advertising partners.

4. Cookies

4.1. Cookies are files with a small amount of data that may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from the Website and stored on your computer's hard drive.





4.2. Like many websites, We use "cookies" to collect information. We use cookies on our Website to collect data about your visit and to allow you to navigate from page to page, count visits, and see which areas and features of our Website are popular. This helps us to gather feedback in order to constantly improve our Website and better serve our customers. Cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not generally store any personal information that you provided to us in your cookies.

4.3. You can control and/or delete cookies if you wish. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being stored therein. If you do this, however, some services and functionalities of our Website may not work.


5. Data retention






7. How we protect personal Information

9. Analytics



12.1. If you want to request that we no longer use and process your information to provide you services, please write us at info@cryptofaces.com. We will respond to your request within 30 days.


13. Law and harm
